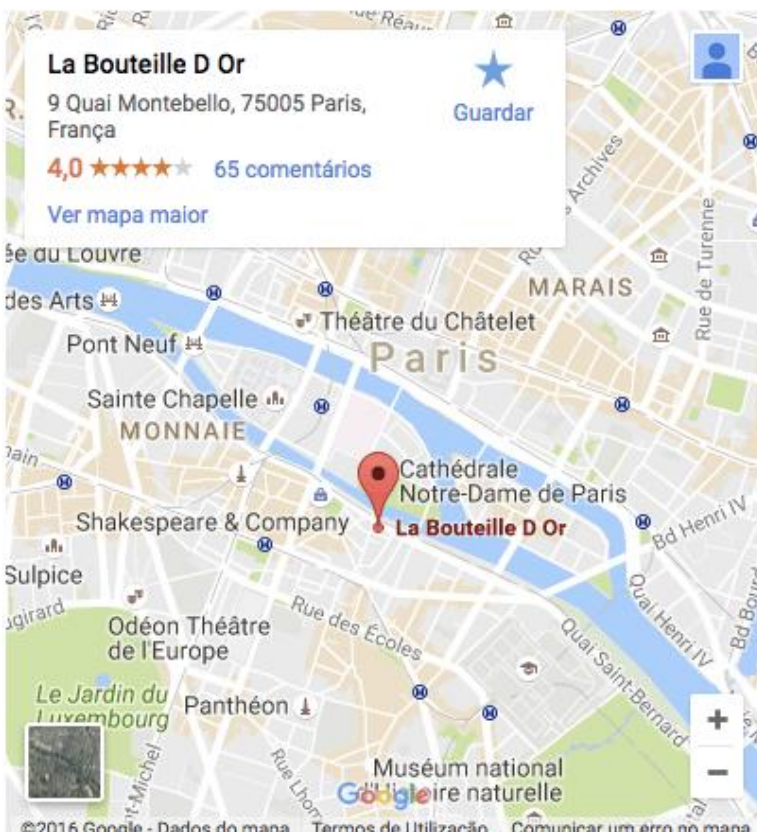

History

La Bouteille d'Or was born in 1631 and served only wine and spirits until the French Revolution in 1789. This tavern, which welcomed as much the aristocrats as the writers, the officers of the King's guard, but also the clergy became a restaurant. One storey, then two, then a whole building built above the restaurant, but La Bouteille d'Or continued to exist, as it still exists today. Moreover, but above all Voltaire, had their habits there.

It is said that Louis XIV himself would have come to drink one of the oldest wines in France, the Le Château Haut-Brion which the Marquis de Roche-gude himself would have made him taste. La Bouteille d'Or has been refurbished between March and July 2011, retaining its beams and its stones which give it all its cachet and all its authenticity. In 20 years, the Bottle of Gold will be 400 years old, four centuries of culinary art which we invite you to come and taste the legacy.
